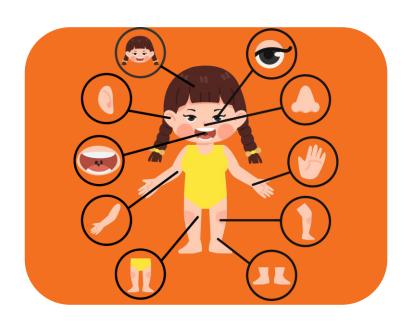

The Importance of Self-Protection

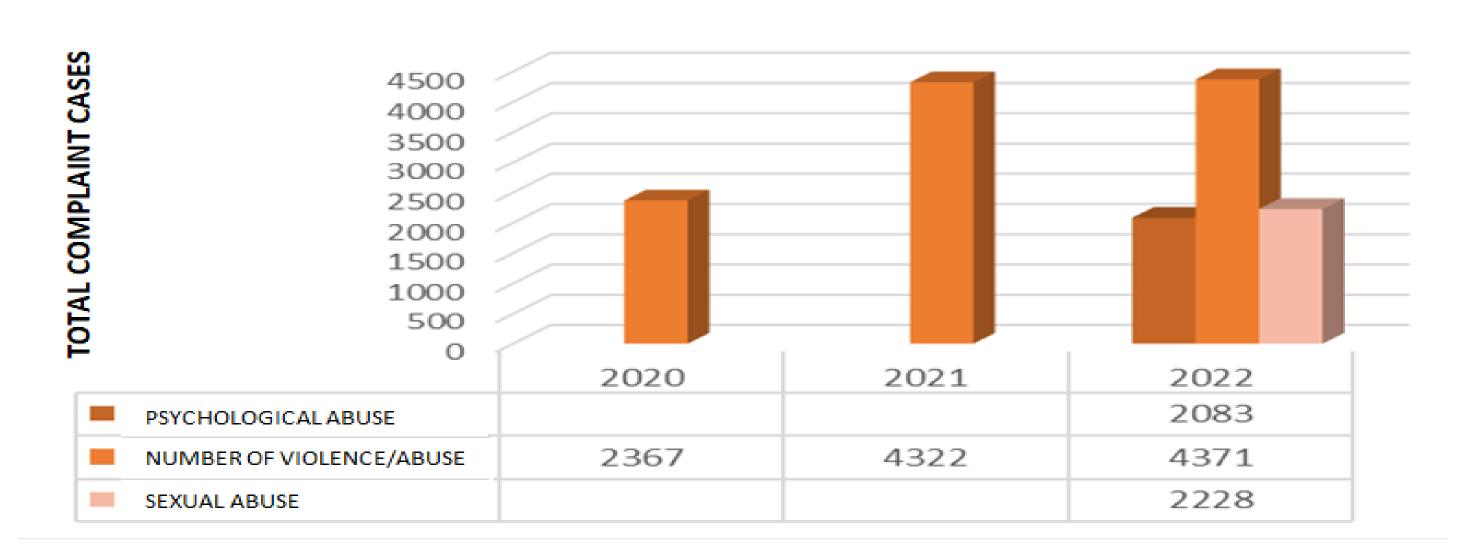
- All parts of the body are important and require to be protected. And psychological threats are equally significant.

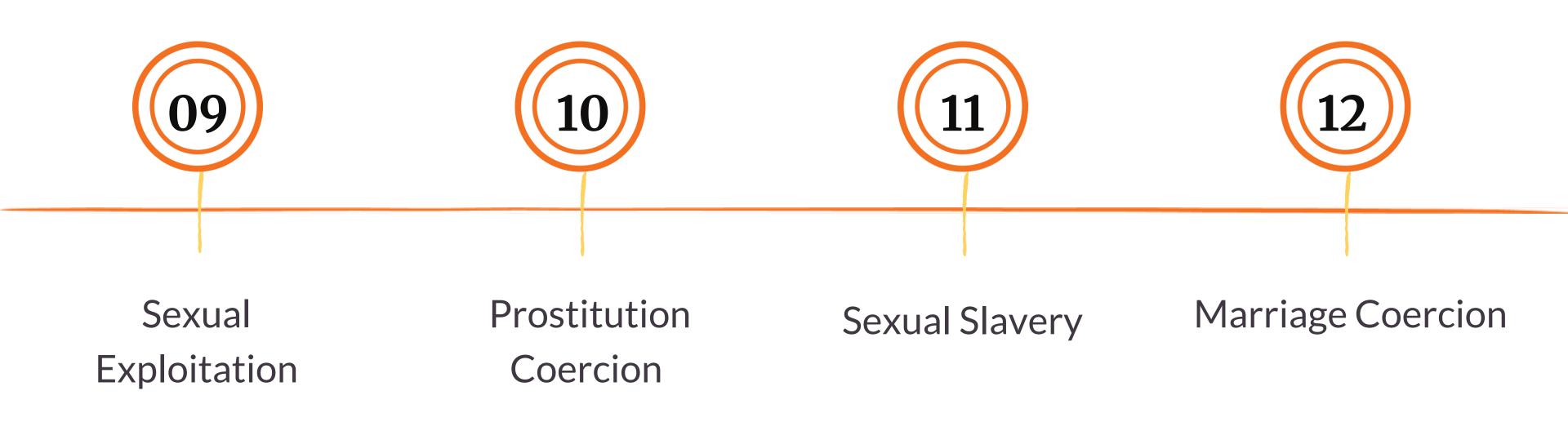

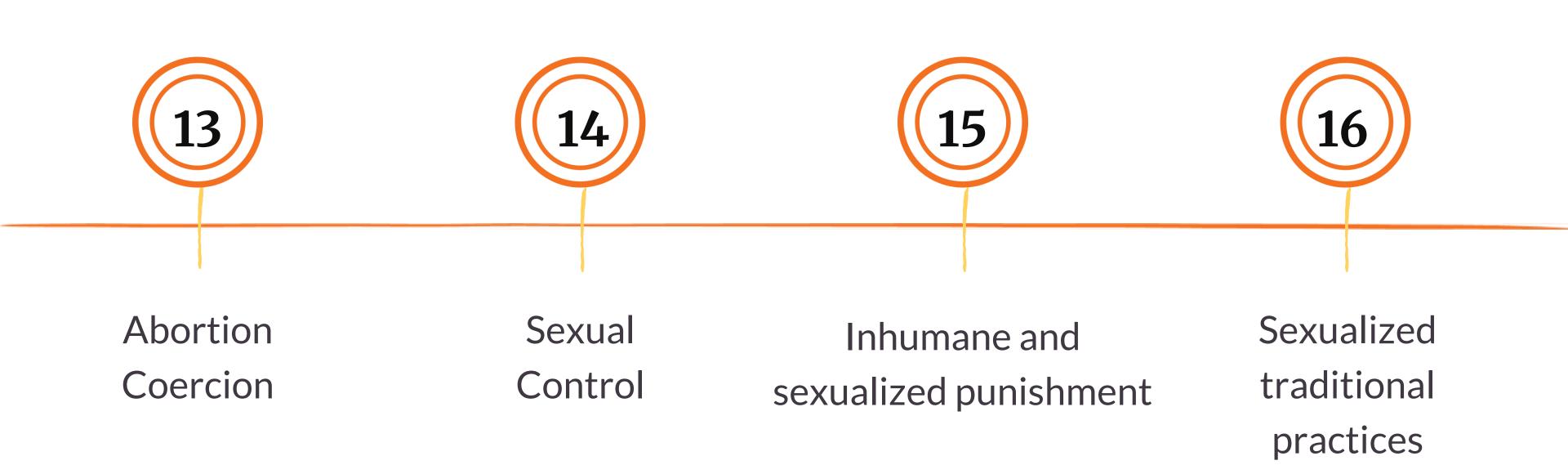

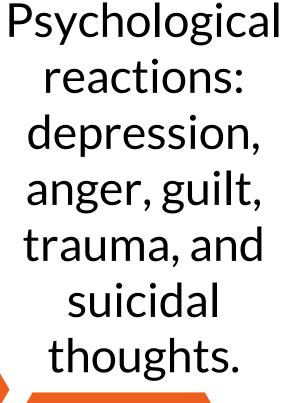


Impacts of Sexual Abuse

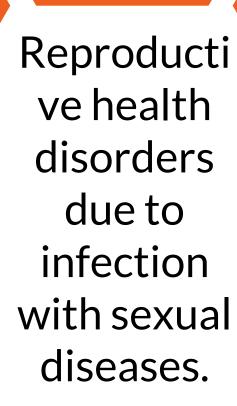
Cuts, bruises, injuries in the genitals and anus



Reproductive disorders: prolonged pain, menstrual disorders, infertility.









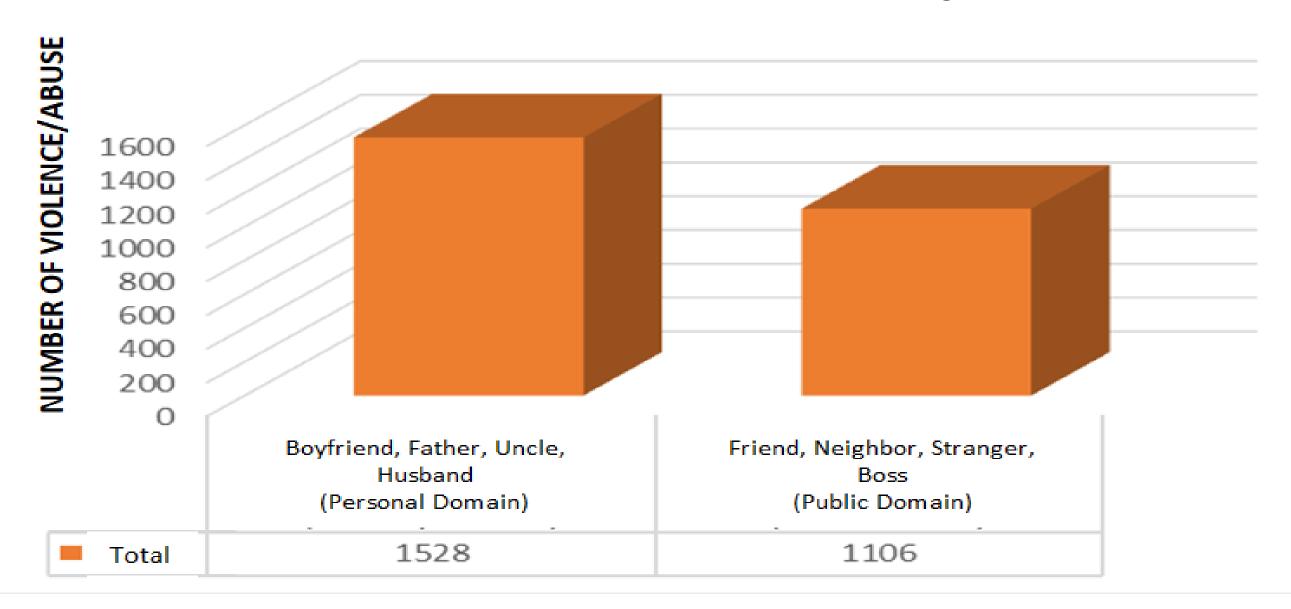
Sexual dysfunction: loss of arousal, hypersexuality, change in sexual orientation.
