What factors contribute to youth defiance?

Early youth tend to be irritable, disobedient, and challenging. This behavior shows attempt to leave behind their old identity and search for a new one. However, it is frequently perceived as a form of conflict with parental authority.

Forms of Gender Stereotype



Personality: Men are considered more logical & assertive, while women are more emotional & nurturing.



Household chores: Women are expected to cook & take care of children, while men do repairs.



Occupation: Women are considered suitable for social professions (nursing), while men for technical (IT).

Denying: "It didn't happen, you're wrong."



Making excuses: "I was tired and forgot."

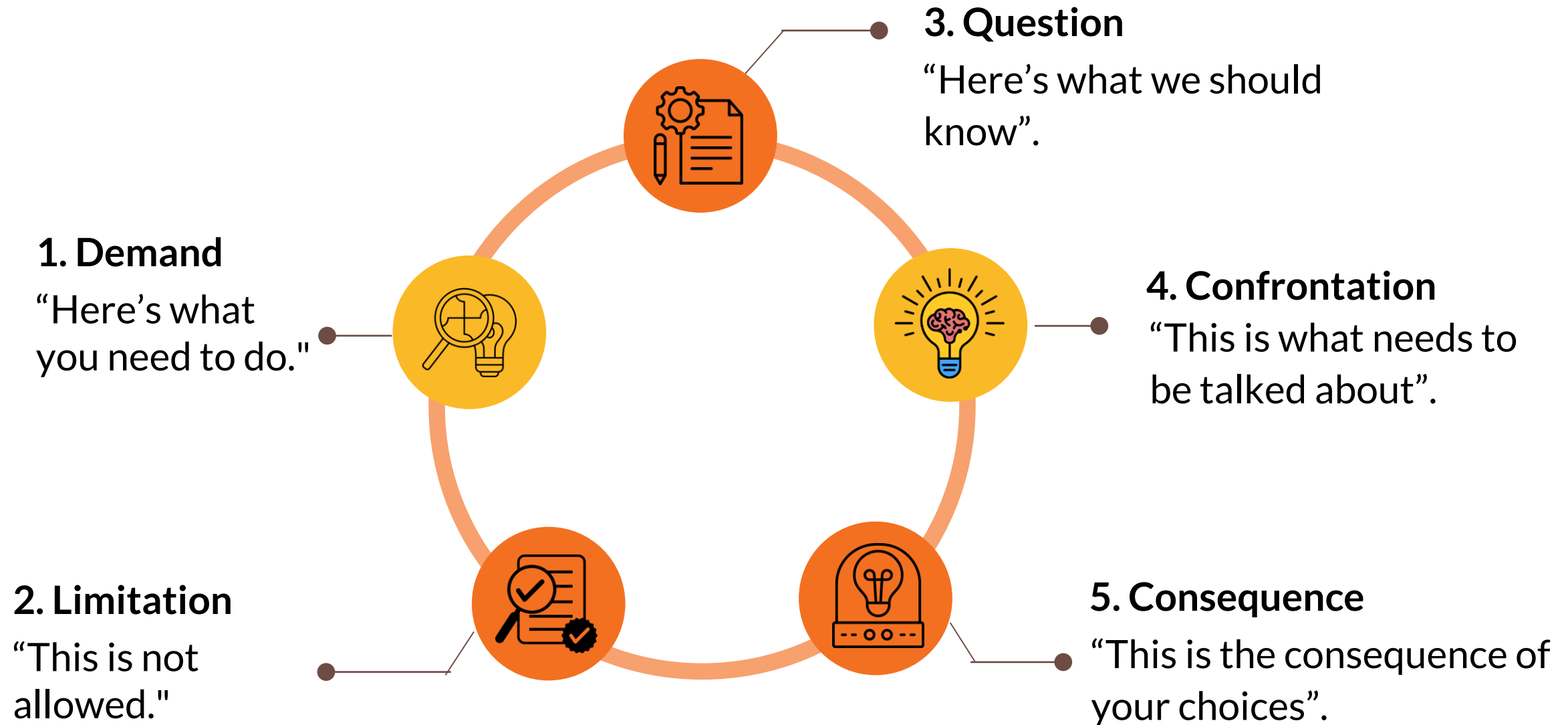


Blaming others: "It's my friend's fault."
