"The ability to understand the feelings, thoughts, and behaviors of others and act accordingly."


Social intelligence frequently manifest through nonverbal communication cues

Foundational Social Norms for Youth



Shake hands when greeting new people



Practicing conversational turn-taking



Maintain eye contact in conversation



Being respectful and not taking items without permission



Utilize proper speech and reply to questions as needed



Demonstrating conversational respect by not responding to digital notifications

Foundational Social Norms for Youth



Ask for permission before doing something



Maintain hygiene, such as covering your mouth when sneezing



Say 'Please' and 'Thank you'





Apologize when making mistakes.
